When trading futures contracts, it is important to note that each contract has an expiration date from which the specific contract can no longer be traded. Close to the expiry date, a new contract will be added to the server, whilst the original contract will be set to close-only mode until its expiration.

Once a futures contract passes its expiration date, trading will no longer be available, this includes closing positions manually from the trading platform. If you have open positions past a contract's expiry date, all open positions and orders will be automatically closed by Leverate using the last available price on the MT4 server.

Open positions and orders will not automatically roll-over to the next futures contract.
